Welcome to the 2023-2024 school year. Your child will have me this year for Science class. I know with your help we can make this a great year for everyone, especially the students.

My Science class will be an interactive, hands-on class. Students will be researching, designing experiments, making observations, and calculating and recording data. The class is structured so that students will have an opportunity to participate in many laboratories.

There will be several projects during the year in which students might need to obtain materials from home. I want to thank you in advance for your cooperation with these assignments. Any student that has trouble obtaining material can come to me and I will help provide that student with materials. These are assigned periodically throughout the school year.

Materials that students will need for my class are as follows:

1. **3 ring binder (1.5 to 2 inches)**
2. **1 package of 5-6 tab dividers for binder**
3. **Spiral notebook (70 Pages)**
4. **Loose leaf paper and pencils**
5. **Highlighters**
6. **Markers and/or colored pencils**

Grades will be based upon an accumulation of points from tests, quizzes, journals, labs, projects, homework, and class work. We have very high expectations at Eastside and the students work very hard during class, because of this, **students will be given homework on an as needed basis, please don't expect it every week in my class.** They will have ample time to complete class work during class.
